Allen HEAD was a Cst. with the OPP when he was charged in Criminal Court for 'contributing to Juvenile Delinquency' (Gross indecency with a 14 yr. old in a parked car in Hamilton). He was convicted and subsequently was 'pressured' into resignation from the Force. He later appealed the resignation, claiming it was offered under duress and was successful in obtaining a Divisional Superior Court ruling for reinstatement. Immediately after reinstatement, OPP charged him under the Ontario Police act with a conduct service offence. While the service charge was pending hearing and OPP were examining an appeal of the Divisional Court ruling, HEAD was again arrested and charged (approx. 2 wks ago) with 'Indecent Assault on a male' (physically approached a young man in a pool room, twice, while the man was involved in a game).
