I understand that various avenues are being explored to settle the above case. In the event that a settlement does take place that does not involve a change in the policy of the R.C.M.P. concerning retention of known homosexuals, I suggest that the Force nevertheless conduct an enquiry to determine whether evidence can be obtained to substantiate the arguments set out in the Aide-Memoire. Otherwise, we will face the same problems when confronted by another plaintiff who finds himself in a position similar to Mr. Stiles.

I regret that I will not be able to assist you on a long-term basis in such an endeavour because I will be leaving on secondment to the War Crimes Prosecutions Group being set up in the Department of Justice. However, I would be pleased to share whatever ideas I have on the matter with you if it would be of help.
