2. Attached is the material referred to including the A-5 from the Deputy DOP(P). The Canadian Forces did an exhaustive internal review and opinion poll on this issue; the results were given to us in the book which is in the possession of the Deputy Commissioner(A). A public opinion poll might not be a prudent endeavour, as one could foresee reservations with expending public funds to "poll" an issue upon which the government has already stated its position.


4. In any event, could you kindly assign a member of your staff to work with S/Sgt. Tough to try and identify the extent of this project, its duration, and whether any additional resources are needed.
