1. At approximately 1530 hrs, 17 FEB 59, accompanied by SM 108585 L Cpl GLENROSS William, Calgary Provost Detachment, I searched the kit of [redacted] 1 QOR of C, in connection with a theft of money from Support Coy, 1 QOR of C. Our file B-1-85 (Cal) refers.
2. Upon searching [redacted]'s locker I found a portfolio, containing a quantity of pornographic photographs. Further search of [redacted] locker revealed obscene booklets, sketches and literature. All pictures and literature were confiscated and are being held at this Detachment as evidence. A list of the seized articles, is attached as Appendix "A".
3. At approximately 2010 hrs, 17 FEB 59, [redacted] was interviewed and stated that he had begun collecting pornographic material in 1951 while stationed at Camp Valcartier, P. Q. He obtained more whilst stationed in Germany from 1951 to 1955. While on leave in Winnipeg, Manitoba in AUG 57, [redacted] said that his brother, [redacted] had given him a number of printed obscene literature, booklets and sketches. These had been printed at [redacted] in WINNIPEG where his brother is employed. A story and two (2) booklets were given to him at Currie Barracks by soldiers who have since been released from the Canadian Army. He added that he had also typed a pornographic story for one unidentified soldier friend at the Support Coy Office. See Appendix "B".
4. Upon questioning [redacted] the following was ascertained:
  - (a) [redacted] is 27 years old, a bachelor, and claimed not to have had sexual intercourse with a woman for the past eight (8) months.
  - (b) When 11 to 13 years old, he and a group of boys used to have carnal knowledge of an 11 year old girl.
  - (c) At the age of 14, [redacted] had unnatural relationships with other boys of the same age, (Fellatio, Sodomy, etc.)
  - (d) He presently expresses a strong desire to commit incest with his 19 year old sister. (N.B. The literature seized in this case contains text pertaining to incest between brother and sister.)
  - (e) Whilst in Germany he performed oral intercourse frequently with a German girl.
  - (f) He said that he wished he was a female, and thinks about this quite often.

At this point, [redacted] expressed the wish to see a psychiatrist regarding his problems.
