1 With reference to SMC letter under file
2200-1-60 (Acting COpM) dated 1 Sep 60 the following
investigation was carried out.

8 Sep 60

2 Stn St Hubert DRO #165 dated 29 Aug 60
lists as released from the RCAP under CR(air)
15.01 item 5(b) (2) " being considered unsuitable
for reasons other than misconduct, ine efficiency or
medical unfitness" effective 15 Aug 60. Address
on release 1645 Mill Ave., Windsor, Ontario.

3 Stn St Hubert Air Force Police file
DS300-13-60 revealed that was released from
Queen Mary Veterans' Hospital to civil police on
suspicion of theft of approximately \$300.00 in
cash and goods from the YMCA, 1441 Drummond St.
Montreal. The theft occurred on 19 Jun 60, at
which time GANSE was registered at the YMCA under
the alias of On 7 Jul 60 was
convicted of theft and on 18 Jul 60 sentenced to
three months in Bordeaux Jail.

7 Sep 60

4 W/C Eric MORTON, SMO, Stn St Hubert,
stated that psychological observation of
had definitely revealed him to be a passive
homosexual. In his interviews with him had
mentioned no names therefore the SMO could supply
no additional information.

5 On this date, interviewed in
Bordeaux Jail, declined to give a written statement
but verbally confirmed what he had previously stated
to Sgt W.M. MacRAE, AFPM (reference Stn St Hubert
file DS300-7-60 d/28 Apr 60). stated that
he knew to be an "active" homosexual; that
had approached him and that he had had
relations with him once, only which was to the best
of his recollection at the beginning of April 58
in the barracks at Stn Senechal. He had later
met while both were on pass from the
in Montreal, approximately May June 58, in bars
and restaurants frequented by homosexuals but had
not had any relations with him asserted that
in his one homosexual relation with he,
was the passive partner in the act. With
reference to mentioned in
SID North report under file 2200-1-60,
stated that to his knowledge never
participated in acts of homosexuality but that he
considered him to be a latent homosexual. Insofar
as concerns relationship with

stated that [redacted], while at Senneterre, went out with this airwoman and also an [redacted], whom [redacted] alleges attempted suicide and was released from the RCAF. Although [redacted] was serious about [redacted] according to [redacted] had no serious intentions towards her.

6 With reference to a [redacted] mentioned in para 6 of Stn St Hubert report, file 83300-7-60, [redacted] stated that this man, whose name he claimed to be [redacted], not [redacted] had had homosexual relations with him on many occasions in Senneterre. He could give no specific details as to places and dates. [redacted] also stated that [redacted], mentioned in the same report, was, to his knowledge, an active homosexual, but that although [redacted] had approached him once while Orderly Corporal and he, [redacted] was canteen steward, he had refused to have anything to do with [redacted]. This incident, [redacted] alleges, took place in early January 1958.

7 [redacted] could not, or would not, supply any further specific details concerning any acts of homosexuality in which he, or other personnel mentioned in this report, had allegedly participated. His answers were found to be vague about any acts of homosexuality in which he himself alleges to have participated; answers such as "all over in Senneterre" "in the barracks" etc, were all that could be obtained from him.

8 The Assistant Governor of Bordeaux Jail stated that GAWNE, with good behaviour, would be released on 29 Sep 60.
