1 This Detachment's reports of even File dated 26 Jul 62 and 13 Aug 62 refer.

2 The alleged homosexual activity of [redacted], age 28 years, Cpl/Adm, on strength of WCAF Station #2ear, has been investigated and results are as outlined in the following paragraphs.

3 This investigation was carried out by means of a limited surveillance, information obtained through confidential informants and personal observations by members of this Detachment, while employed on other investigative duties. [redacted]'s social activities since this investigation commenced on 7 Aug 62 have been negligible. No evidence was uncovered that suggestive homosexual activity exists at WCAF Station #2ear, nor has [redacted] been associating with known Service and Civilian homosexuals in the Harris-Griffith-Toronto areas.

4 No evidence came to light that [redacted], age 42, Cpl/TASd, 19A Toronto, the subject of the initial investigation, and [redacted] have had personal contact since the latter's transfer to Europe in 1950. In this regard it is submitted that the persons specifically named in this report have not been stationed at the same units, and the distances between their former units would definitely preclude personal contact. This Detachment's investigation definitely eliminates any association between [redacted] and [redacted] since the surveillance began on [redacted]'s activities as of 7 Aug 62. In fact, [redacted] was not aware that [redacted] is still in Toronto.

5 [redacted] was interviewed by the undersigned investigators on 10 Sep 62, under caution of W(Air)101.12 and gave a voluntary statement which is attached as Appendix "A" to this report. Briefly summarizing [redacted]'s statement:

- (a) he admits that he was introduced to and on several occasions had homosexual relations with [redacted],
- (b) he denies continuing homosexual activities after leaving Toronto in 1950, and
- (c) he admits frequent past and current acts of masturbation.

6 As there is no evidence of present homosexual activity by [redacted] or other persons at WCAF Station #2ear, this investigation is concluded.
