Suspected Homosexual Activities

1 Attached is a copy of a letter received from the CO Stn Vancouver in which he expresses deep concern that involvement in homosexual activities by service personnel occupying sensitive positions may seriously affect security.

2 Investigation in the Vancouver area has resulted in release action for three RCFs, all of whom admitted being involved in homosexual activity, and who have stated to investigating authorities that they were motivated by press reports of the Admiralty security case and an explanation of the security implications of their own involvement to reveal not only their own problem but also the suspected involvement of other RCAF personnel as indicated in MSH's report X202-2-62 dated 16 Nov.

3 A recent incident at Stn Goose Bay, which was reported to your HQ in our X202-2-62 (30 Dec) 10 Dec, and information revealed during a recent security staff visit, indicates that telecommunications personnel of that unit may be involved in such activities. This information is being further developed and will be forwarded to your HQ as soon as possible.

4 While this command is following the provisions of CAFAC 19.00/17, it is considered that such activity, which could seriously affect security, should be brought to your attention for such action as you may consider necessary.

5 The CO Stn Vancouver has been advised to ensure the continuation of the present investigation and to submit progress reports to this CRQ.
