- 2 During the discussion mentioned above, [redacted] remarked that from his knowledge of [redacted], he was inclined to agree with the SMO's opinion of the case. He enquired into the possibility of this incident not being reported to AFHQ and when told that WSIU was bound to report, he requested that the matter be reported in a separate report.
- 3 With all due respect to [redacted]'s professional ability, it is pointed out that [redacted] was not referred to or examined by a qualified psychiatrist, which the former is not.
