Having been duly cautioned in accordance with CR(Air)Art 101.12
I wish to make the following statement:- Signed [REDACTED]

When in Toronto, I have stayed at the Ford Hotel, 595 Bay St,
YMCA College St and with an Ex-Instructor from the RCAF Staff College
now working as a School Teacher during the evenings. His name is [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] living now at [REDACTED]. His
approx age is 28 yrs old and single. While staying as a guest, I sleep
on a chesterfield in the living room.

I have visited while in Toronto the following bars :- Colonial,
Yonge St, Zansibar, Brown Derby, Park Plaza, Embassy, Place Pigalle(College
hangout) and Yorkville area.

Approximately three years ago, I was approached once in New York
in Times Square and asked by both a man and a woman for a blow job.

In reference to the incident of the 18 July 1965. I first
started out in the Ford Hotel at 4 pm, the place where I was staying.
I had approx 8 - 10 beers until just before closing. I drove my car up
Bay St to St Josephs St and parked my 1963 Chev, licence [REDACTED] on the corner.
I locked my wallet containing all my credentials in the car trunk. I went
up Bay St to Cumberland and Yorkville area, and I visited a few coffee
houses namely the Purple Onion and Mousehole. I sat around and drank a coffee.
From here I walked down Avenue Rd, past the Museum to the corner with a
fence and proceeded inside the bushes to urinate. There were several
people walking around and in the process of urinating, someone in plain
clothes came from behind me and shouted 'Get him'. With this I ran out
into the cleared area and something was thrown at me. I continued and
when the man in pursuit mentioned he had a gun I stopped dead. When
he came up to me, he hit me over the head with the gun and handcuffed one

wrist. From here I was put on the ground under a tree and someone else brought over some other guy and handcuffed us together. I now know this man to be [REDACTED]. Prior to this incident I had never seen or heard of the above mentioned person.

During my period of service in the RCAF (enlisted [REDACTED]) I have had no relations or knowledge of Homosexuality involving RCAF personnel or civilians.
