

MINISTERIAL INQUIRY  
HOMOSEXUALITY

Reference: A. SEC CP memorandum dated 19 Jan 68

1. The CFMS does not have any policy per se regarding homosexuality but is merely an "as required" instrument in implementing the policies defined by the security and legal branches.
2. In suspected cases of homosexuality the commanding officer may solicit the assistance of the medical officer in investigating or substantiating the suspicion. A psychiatric interview may be conducted at the request of the commanding officer to aid in the substantiation of a reported case of homosexuality or at the request of the person to be released with a view to counselling and rehabilitation.
3. Release of suspected individuals is subject to the concurrence of DPLS and the Surgeon General.
