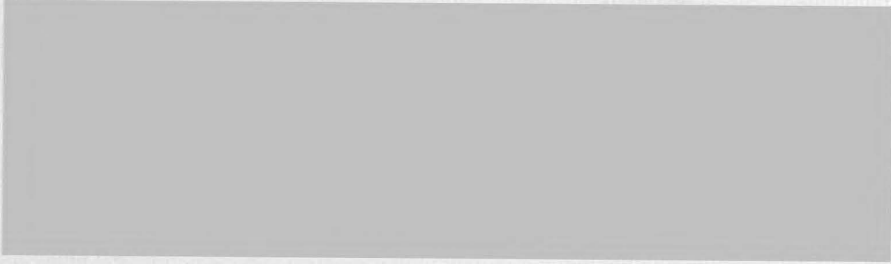

2. On 22 Feb 78, this Section received a memorandum, file number SH 110-4-78(A/Det Comd ADSIU) dated 22 Feb 78 requesting the following:

- a. [redacted] be interviewed in regards to the homosexual activities of [redacted] while at [redacted]
- b. [redacted] be interviewed in regards to a letter written by [redacted] to [redacted] at CFRS, [redacted] in which [redacted] is alleged to have admitted being "gay"; and
- c. to identify [redacted]

This request was in support of WDSIU Section Winnipeg file SW 110-1-78 dated 03/14 Feb 78.

3. At about 1030 hrs, 27 Feb 78, Sgt FORWARD and I interviewed [redacted] at [redacted]. A voluntary written statement was obtained and a copy is attached as Annex A. The following are the pertinent points of this interview and statement:

- a. she first met [redacted] at [redacted] while she was attending her [redacted] during the fall 1977;
- b. that [redacted] had mentioned to her that [redacted] had attacked [redacted], tried to take her clothes off and kiss her. This she believed took place in the shower of the female MP barracks, [redacted]
- c. this was the only incident of this nature she recalls [redacted] telling her about;
- d. [redacted] never mentioned anything to her about this incident;
- e. [redacted] would drop into her room and would bring the topic of conversation around to drugs or homosexuality. They would cite a hypothetical incident about two people being involved in either drugs or sexual deviation, and ask what the CF policy would be in regards to the incident. She felt that when they were talking about these hypothetical people, they were in fact talking about themselves;
- f. she informed them that homosexuality was not tolerated in the Forces and especially in the Military Police trade;

- g. she found that a tense atmosphere existed in the room occupied by [REDACTED] which indicated to her that a possible homosexual love affair may exist amongst the roommates; however, she saw nothing to confirm her suspicions;
- h. she was never approached or saw any homosexual incidents while at [REDACTED] and [REDACTED];
- j. she made an attempt in the late fall, 1977 to report her suspicions to MWO ROOBER, MP Training Company, CFSIS, however, he departed on course before she was able to do so. She did not report her suspicions to other training staff members as she did not trust their discretion.
4. At about 1100 hrs, 01 Mar 78, Sgt FORWARD and I interviewed [REDACTED], c/c "D" Coy, [REDACTED], and a voluntary written statement was obtained; a copy is attached as Annex B. Following are the pertinent points of the interview and statement;
- about Jul 77 she came into possession of a letter supposedly written by [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] in which [REDACTED] admitted to being "gay" and in love with [REDACTED];
  - [REDACTED] had the letter for five weeks before giving it to Cpl(W) GREENOUGH, Training Staff, who immediately turned it over to her;
  - the letter was not signed and [REDACTED] denied writing it;
  - [REDACTED] was not sure if it was [REDACTED] who wrote the letter;
  - both [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] were suspected of being homosexuals;
  - investigation carried out by her at the school could not substantiate their allegations;
  - LCol ALLAN, School Commandant, decided that due to the lack of substantiation no further action would be taken;
  - the letter was later forwarded to [REDACTED] at their request, with a statement by Capt(W) CONNOR in regards to the incident; and
  - she identified [REDACTED] as shown in para 1.b. of this report.
