CASE SYNOPSIS

BACKGROUND

1. As an admitted bisexual who would have homosexual relationships from two to six times a year, [REDACTED] was the subject of a Career Review Board (CRB) in Mar 90. At the time, he was serving on a BE, having enrolled [REDACTED]. When offered a 5(d) release under the interim homosexual policy, [REDACTED] refused, and remained in the CF with career restrictions.

2. Although his BE expired 3 Jan 92, [REDACTED] was offered and accepted an extension of six months. His present term of service expires 31 Jul 92.

3. On [REDACTED], [REDACTED] was convicted of two offences under the Criminal Code of Canada, namely pointing a firearm (Section 86(1)(b)), for which he was fined \$500.00, and possession of a restricted weapon (Section 91(2)(b)), for which he was fined \$200.00 and placed on probation for two years.

4. In May 92, [REDACTED] was interviewed by his CO and advised that, owing to the weapons convictions, he was not being recommended for re-engagement. [REDACTED] apparently contacted Mr. Sven Robinson, MP, after this interview.

5. [REDACTED]'s CO has advised NDHQ that [REDACTED] will be released IAW QR&O 15.01 5(c) with a suitability factor of C. No inquiries from Mr. Robinson's office have been received, and there has been no media interest in this case to date.
