Policy - Personnel alleged to have committed Homosexual and Indecent Acts or Suspected of Homosexual Tendencies

- Enclosed are several copies of the current policy on the above subject. This policy was formulated in Feb of 1950 and remains substantially the same today. You will note however that the policy was framed under the old KR(Air) and that certain references contained are to paras in that publication. Wherever they occur they should be disregarded. Discharge action should be taken in all cases under Article 15.01 sub para 2(b) - "inefficiency through continued unsatisfactory service".
- It will be immediately evident that this para is not entirely appropriate and KR(Air) is being amended to include an appropriate para for homosexual cases. The amendment to KR(Air) should be published in several weeks. In the meantime it will be necessary for you to invoke the provisions of para 2(b) as stated above. Care must be taken that the Medical Board proceedings on discharge contain the opinion that the man in question is a homosexual or has homosexual tendencies.
- When the above mentioned amendment is made to KR(Air) appropriate amendments will be issued to the present policy on homosexual cases.
