Attached is a copy of President Eisenhower's Executive Order on security in the U.S. Government, together with sample Security Regulations.

- 2. The Order and Regulations will undoubtedly be of interest to members of the Sub-Panel, particularly where they may throw any new light on Canadian security measures. The security requirements are stringent and call for a far larger investigative force then is in existence in Canada. However, in requiring a security clearance for persons holding government posts, which in fact require no security protection, they may possibly tend to weaken security in more vital positions.
- 3. It has been suggested that members of the Sub-Panel might welcome a round-table discussion of the more interesting points in the Executive Order.
