Dear Mr. Bryce:

This has reference to our exchange of correspondence touching on research to be carried out by Dr. F.R. WAKE. As you will recall, Dr. WAKE's efforts were to be directed at development of a test or tests suitable for use as an aid to identification of person's having homosexual tendencies or other related character defects. Tests of this nature could be of inestimable value in minimizing the possibility of candidates having such weaknesses receiving government appointments in the first instance, as well as providing an opportunity for appropriate administrative action should persons in this category be already employed in sensitive positions.

We would welcome information concerning the substance of progress reports submitted by Dr. WAKE in relation to this project. If, on the other hand, a submission has not yet been made, may we be informed of the approximate date by which we might anticipate receiving the requested information.
