RE: NATIONAL GAY RIGHTS COALITION

In July, 1975 the Canadian homosexual groups banded together to form a national coalition to fight for their rights and the elimination of Anti-homosexual legislation.

Their methods would take the form of demonstrations, national campaigns, and briefs to government. They also want to publicize certain individual cases to gain notoriety. There was also a womens caucus organized at that time as a permanent part of the coalition.

To-date the homosexual demonstrations have been peaceful

and orderly and have not concerned the city police.

You will note the attached article, shows the N.G.R.C. is going after the Solicitor General to discuss discrimination against homosexuals by the R.C.M.P.

Over the last year or two, the liberal thinkers have been thinking its only a matter of time before all Police departments will have to accept, all races of people, all religions, homosexuals, and that height and weight cannot continue to exclude membership in the Police. In the USA some Police departments have already hired homosexuals, because, no doubt of political pressure applied on them.
