In August, 1961, we forwarded a paper to provide investigators engaged on character enquiries with some insight into the security and investigative problems presented by the homosexual.

- (c) Letter dated September 16, 1976 from the Privy Council Office outlining U.S. Civil Service Commission stand on employing homosexuals.
