Dear Mr. Fulton:

On February 3, 1961 the Secretary of the Security Panel provided me with copies of a memorandum entitled "Security Cases Involving Homosexuality" which had been passed to the Prime Minister and you by the Clerk of the Privy Council on February 2, 1961. The Secretary advised that this memorandum was to be used for discussion at a meeting of the special committee of the Security Panel which, it was anticipated, would be attended by both the Prime Minister and yourself.

2. As you are aware the memorandum embodies proposals for Terms of Reference within which our investigations can be carried out and we had hoped to have these necessary authorities some time ago. The difficulties encountered in processing cases involving homosexuality have increased proportionately with the number of government employees identified since our original request for a Cabinet directive in May 1960. In addition, the lack of any clear-cut directive increases the amount of correspondence required in each case. The combination of these two factors presents a continuing undesirable situation.

3. I would appreciate any action that you can take to secure the Terms of Reference we require to alleviate many of the problems with which we are confronted in continuing our investigation into this character weakness.


