Reference your memo of 81-02-18 attached.

The attached correspondence, forwarded to all Area Commanders on 78-11-07, outlines current procedure relative to homosexual screening investigations.

As indicated, we do not conduct investigations on homosexuals unless they are candidates for a security clearance. We also do not employ sources targeted against homosexuals. The sources utilized in this field are casual sources who have during previous interviews indicated a willingness to assist in security screening investigations.

We do not gather information on homosexuals in general other than indicated on the attached. Although policy allows Area Commands to submit data received from local morality squads, only BCAC submits such information for record purposes. We have not encouraged the practice as it is felt by some to be discriminatory. Perhaps the time has come to put an end to it. If you agree, we will advise the field accordingly.
