## MEMBER

4. a. Ensure all inquiries and interviews of homosexuals or suspected homosexuals comply with the provision of 2.a. and are conducted with sensitivity, tact, discretion, maturity of judgement and absence of bias.

1. Report only information relevant to a justified inquiry.

2. In security screening cases, avoid any personal comment as to whether the individual should be afforded access to classified material.

b. Where allegations of homosexuality arise during an investigation, e.g. security screening, attempt to the fullest extent possible to obtain independent corroborative information.

c. When conducting inquiries or interviews, explore fully how the subject copes with homosexuality with emphasis upon whether he or she is embarrassed or secretive about it and if vulnerable to compromise, blackmail or indiscretion.

d. Provide a full assessment of all sources reporting homosexual information, including the basis for the source's belief.

## 5. NATIONAL ANALYST

5. a. Include in intelligence assessments relating to homosexuality only those allegations or facts which are fully and factually reported and identification is certain, based on information provided by sources whose reliability has been properly assessed.
