RECRUITING POLICY
SEXUAL ORIENTATION

(1)

1. At the meeting with the Deputy Minister, Department of Justice, held on 1 Mar 90, the question was raised as to whether or not an applicant for employment in the CF was asked to declare his sexual orientation.

2. According to DRS, the applicant is not asked the question unless, in the course of the interview, there is reason to believe that he/she is gay. If the recruiter has reason to believe that the applicant is gay, then they are asked the question directly. If the answer is "yes", the interview is terminated and the application is rejected. If the answer is "no", then the statement is accepted and the applicant continues with the recruiting process.
